Your elected Bargaining Team met with management late into the nights of June 17 and 20. Some progress is being made, but management continues to ignore information requests about safety and staffing and still hasn't gotten serious about fixing short staffing to ensure safe patient care.

## **New Tentative Agreements:**

- Guaranteed uniforms for gardeners and EVS workers
- Juneteenth holiday added to our MOU



- Expanded bereavement leave
- Increased training pay for all three contracts and new preceptor pay for General Unit and San Leandro Hospital contracts

We have two sessions
left (Monday the 24th and
Wednesday the 26th), and
we intend to have a tentative
agreement after these sessions.
If we do not have an agreement
by that time, the Bargaining
Team will explore all options,
including announcing a
strike. Purple up to remind
management we voted 99.5%
to strike!
