Chapter Officers and Duties

President: The President shall officiate at all meetings and shall be responsible for directing the implementation of directives voted on by the Chapter membership. The President shall be an ex-officio member of all committees.

Vice President: The Vice President shall act as President in the absence of the President.

Secretary: The Secretary shall keep a correct record of the proceedings of all Chapter Board and General Membership meetings and shall provide a copy thereof to the Secretary of the Local Union upon request. The Secretary shall receive all correspondence and communications on behalf of the Chapter.

Chief Steward: The Chief Steward shall serve as a resource for shop stewards in carrying out their duties at the worksite.

Information Officer: The Information Officer shall be responsible for maintaining communication with the General Membership. Roles and responsibilities of the Information Officer include, but are not limited to: maintain social media platforms used by the Chapter, send email communication to inform members of union activities, meetings, etc.

COPE Coordinator/Delegate and County COPE Committee: The COPE Coordinator/Delegate shall be responsible for providing political information and education to the members of the chapter. S/he shall assist and coordinate with turnout, COPE cards, and other duties related to political activities of the chapter and Local Union. The coordinator will also be one of the chapter representatives/delegates to the Local 1021 County COPE Committee.
